Clothing & Personal Gear

- ☐ Lightweight layers
- ☐ Long-sleeve shirts
- ☐ Fleece or warm mid-layer
- ☐ Warm jacket
- ☐ Comfortable walking shoes
- ☐ Hat or beanie
- ☐ Gloves
- ☐ Extra socks
- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Lip balm

Road Trip Essentials

- ☐ Reusable water bottles / extra drinking water
- ☐ Cooler with food and snacks
- ☐ Offline maps or downloaded directions
- ☐ Phone charger and car charging cable
- ☐ Portable power bank
- ☐ Camera / extra batteries or charging gear
- ☐ Paper map
- ☐ Cash and cards
- ☐ Trash bags
- ☐ Hand sanitizer and wipes

Emergency & Vehicle Gear

- ☐ First-aid kit
- ☐ Flashlight or headlamp
- ☐ Extra blanket
- ☐ Jumper cables or portable jump starter
- ☐ Tire pressure gauge
- ☐ Spare tire / tire repair kit
- ☐ Basic roadside emergency kit
- ☐ Extra windshield washer fluid
- ☐ Check coolant / antifreeze before the trip
- ☐ Tire chains or traction equipment if late-season mountain travel requires

Mountain & Higher-Elevation Drives

- ☐ Check road conditions before leaving
- ☐ Check weather at your destination and along the route
- ☐ Pack extra warm clothing
- ☐ Allow extra travel time for changing conditions
- ☐ Check seasonal road closures
- ☐ Know where your next fuel stop is
- ☐ Fill the gas tank before entering remote areas

Scenic Stops & Short Hikes

- ☐ Daypack
- ☐ Water and snacks
- ☐ Binoculars
- ☐ Camera
- ☐ Walking poles if useful
- ☐ Small sit pad or travel blanket
- ☐ Basic navigation app / offline map

If You're Traveling With Your Dog

- ☐ Leash and backup leash
- ☐ Collapsible water bowl
- ☐ Plenty of fresh water
- ☐ Dog food and treats
- ☐ Dog waste bags
- ☐ Dog first-aid supplies
- ☐ Towel or blanket
- ☐ Dog jacket or extra layer for cold weather
- ☐ Paw protection for rough, icy, or snowy conditions
- ☐ Current ID tags and vaccination information

Before You Leave

- ☐ Check Nevada road conditions and weather
- ☐ Confirm fuel stops
- ☐ Download maps
- ☐ Tell someone your route if traveling remotely
